



Prince George Rod and Gun Club Policy on Range Closures

From time to time it is necessary to close a range or ranges due to special events or shooting competitions. Circumstance that would require range closures could include:

1. During competitions when noise from regular use would affect the ability of competitors to concentrate on their course of fire, when the range would actually be in use by competitors, or if that competition's course of fire would have safety implications for other users.
2. When particular ranges are rented for exclusive use.
3. When needed for special events such as the annual June Family Heritage Day.

The policy on Range closures is that as soon as the date is known for a range closure, the party responsible for the event, or rental coordinator shall advise the web master so that the date may be posted on the club web site. In addition, a notice of range closure that clearly indicates the date and reason for closure must be posted upon the affected range or ranges. In the case of a general range closure, notice must be posted both on the Black Powder Range and at the main gate no less than two week in advance and preferably as soon as the date is known.

If an event is not posted in time, the privilege to hold that event in subsequent years may be revoked by the club executive and directors.
